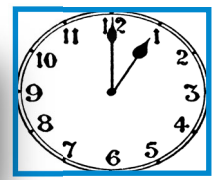

Respect-Life Committee Corner

On May 29, the U.S Supreme Court rejected a challenge to a new law in Arkansas that requires doctor's performing medical abortions (i.e., via the abortion pill RU-486), to have admitting privileges at a local hospital, in case that are complications for the patient due to the chemical abortion. In support of the Supreme Court's decision, Arkansas Attorney General Leslie Rutledge said "As Attorney General, I have fully defended this law at every turn and applaud the Supreme Court's decision against Planned Parenthood today. Protecting the health and well-being of women and the unborn will always be a priority."
